Competitors must submit a written justification, confirmed by the authorities of the parent club. Information about the withdrawal from the competition must be sent to the Competition Office at the latest before the Administrative Checks.

Article 4 Competition numbers, Advertising

Competition numbers:

The organiser shall provide each participant with at least two sets of Competition numbers. A set of Competition numbers must be clearly displayed on both sides of the car throughout the Competition.

An additional set of Competition numbers (maximum height 15 cm) must be placed on the right side of the windscreen (or, if the car has no windscreen, on a forward-facing part of the car) and on the left side of the rear window.

Cars without their correct Competition numbers shall not be allowed to take the start.

Advertising:

The organiser has made the following advertising arrangements:

- obligatory (starting number) - placement in accordance with Appendix 2 and 2a of these regulations,
- obligatory – Valvoline - placement in accordance with Appendix 2 and 2a of these regulations,
- optional – placement in accordance with Appendix 2 and 2a of these regulations.

Article 6 – Insurance

A) Organiser

In accordance with legal requirements, the organiser has taken out one or more insurance policies against the following risks:

- Third Party Insurance in the amount of 10 000 000 PLN (€2 225 000 approx.) for the event.

- Accident insurance – coverage in the event of permanent damage to the health of 20 000 PLN (€4500 approx.)

The organiser's third party insurance is valid for the entire duration of the Competition, not only during official practice and race heats but also for travelling from the parking area to the course of the Competition and back.

B) Competitor/Driver

Regarding to GSMP: Every competitor/driver is obliged to have civil liability policy of vehicle or athlete, presented to participation in competition. It is recommended to have AUTO-CASCO insurance with extension of the racing risk.

Article 7 – Protests and appeals

Protest fee: 100% of required entry fee – paid in cash.

Appeal fee set by the PZM: **2500 PLN.**

Appeal fee set by the FIA: **6000 €.**

Any protest must be lodged in accordance with the prescriptions of the Code. Protests must be made in writing and given to the clerk of the course or to his assistant, or in their absence to a steward, accompanied by the requisite protest fees.

If the protest requires the dismantling and re-assembly of various parts of a car, the claimant must also pay a deposit which shall be set by the stewards.

Competitors have the right to appeal, as established in Articles 15.1 to 15.4 of the Code and as provided for in the regulations of the International Court of Appeal.

Article 8 – Podium, Prizes and Awards

8.1 Trophies/cups

A) **FIA-CEZ** – Cups for 1,2,3 place in each group

B) **GSMP** – according with the GSMP 2021 Regulations.

C) **MMSR** - according with the MMSR 2021 Regulations.

8.2 It is the responsibility of each competitor and driver taking part in the competition to participate in the awards ceremony.

8.3 It is also the responsibility of each competitor and driver to take care of professional level of awards ceremony through the proper behavior of the competitor and the driver and his team members, personal participation in the award ceremony and taking the awards in the athlete's outfit, i.e. in the fastened suit and footwear provided for by the regulations for motor sports.

8.4 Each identified unjustified violation of the rules by the competitor or the driver to comply with the obligations set out (in article 14.1.1 of the GSMP Reg. Framework) will be treated as unsportsmanlike conduct and, at the request of the Clerk of the Course, by the decision of the Stewards, a penalty will be imposed in accordance with article 14.5 of the GSMP Regulations.

Article 9 – Additional provisions by the organiser

9.1 Organizers of motorsport events are committed to decisive action against fans shouting racist, fascist, anti-Semitic, nationalist, satanic, grossly unethical, praising terrorism, inciting strife and hatred, and for displaying inscriptions and signs with this content.

9.2. In special justified cases, the organizer allows for an additional administrative checks and scrutineering after 18:00 on May 21, 2021 for a fee of PLN 300.

9.3. The right to interpret these regulations is reserved by GKSS. For matters not covered in these regulations, the relevant provisions of the Code of Competition and its appendices shall apply.

9.4. Application for the GSMP round is equivalent to the competitor / driver's consent to the processing of his personal data related to the organization of the above-mentioned round and publishing photos and results on the websites of the PZM and the round organizer. The competitor / driver has the right to access their personal data, correct them and demand that their data be no longer processed. The request to stop processing your personal data is equivalent to resignation from participation in the above-mentioned round.

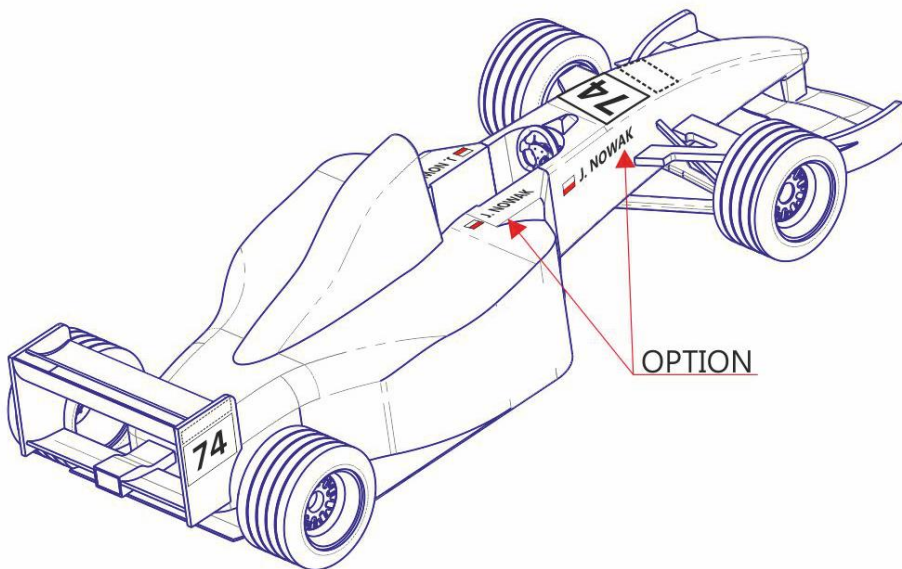

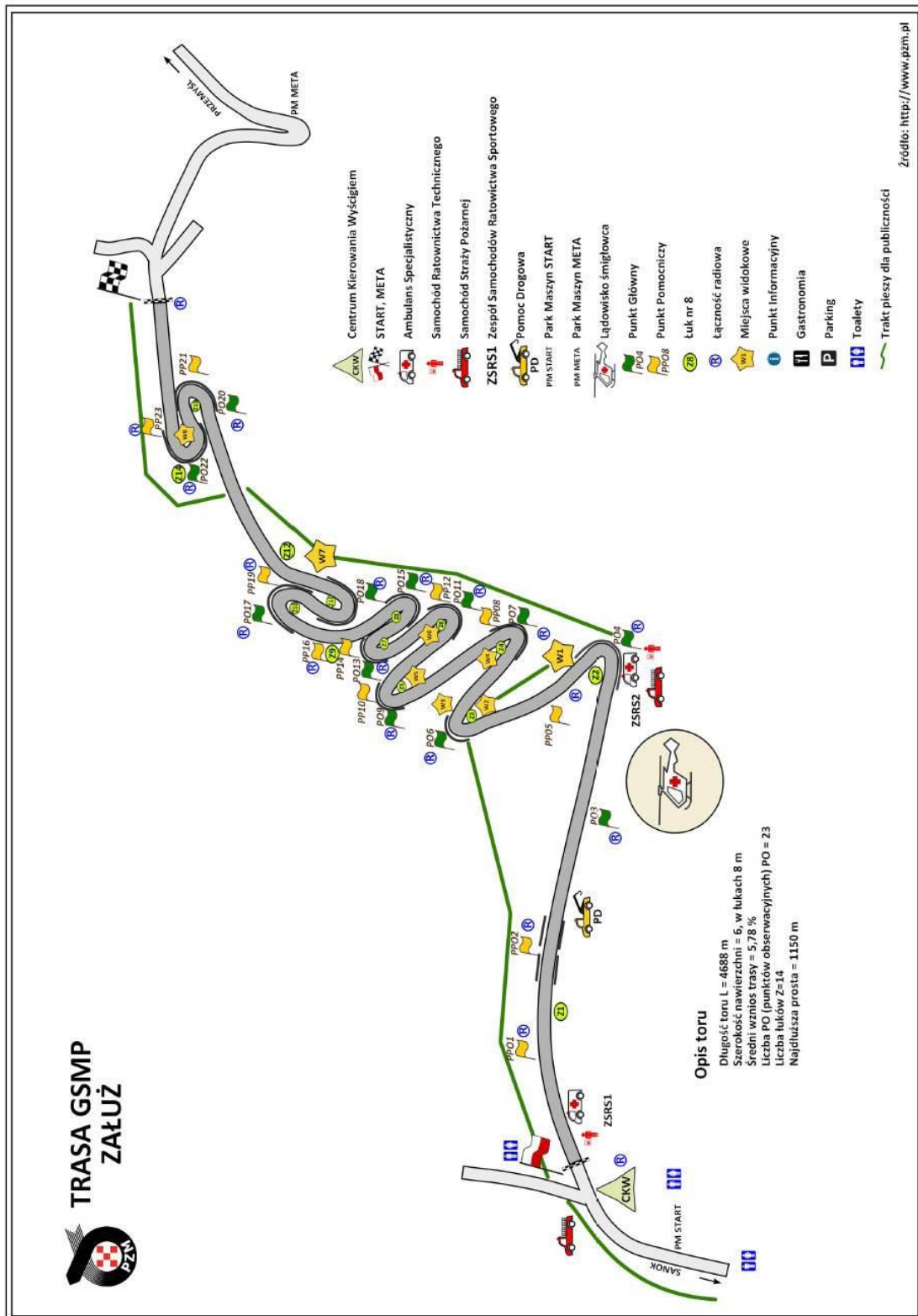
Appendix 2a Location of the starting numbers and organiser's advertisement stickers
